Bridgeport Road (at Bridgeport Village), Tigard; 503-639-5711 Walk to: Bridgeport Village Stadium 18 Staging area: This nook offers cozy wooden booths and a state-of-the-art *Enomatic wine-dispensing system*, so you can taste a 2003 Opus One Cabernet blend without having to break the bank on the entire \$215 bottle. It's a little shot of the fabulous life for about the price of concession stand popcorn. Sip/nibble: 26 wines plus eight cocktails of Split's own concoction. Chef Leather Storrs of Noble Rot and Rocket restaurants helped craft Split's menu of small bites, which includes five salads and 10 appetizers. Pre-funk proclamation: Pinot noir for "Pirates of the Caribbean"? Chardonnay to accompany "Hairspray"? Bartender Misty Woodcock plays cinematic sommelier: "Champagne definitely goes with a good comedy. The bubbles add extra tickles."
